

# **Minutes of the Most Recent UCRCs Club Meeting**

## **July, 2011**

### **TREASURY REPORT:**

Neil Ranft reviewed the Club's expenses, income and resulting bank balances.

### **CLUB OPERATIONS:**

Flying at the field requires both a club membership and an AMA membership. Members are reminded to pay club dues for 2011 and insure you have an AMA membership.

### **NEW BUSINESS:**

- 1) Minutes of the Club meeting for June 2011 were accepted as revised.
- 2) Welcome new members Tom Wilmoth and his daughter Isabella and Anthony Turner and his daughter Brianna.
- 3) Bob M. provided update on our fund raiser at the Sparta Air Show September 17. Event will require big turnout of club members to man the booth during the day of the event.
- 4) The city has installed the electrical pole near the mower shed and we will have power turned on for the electric fly-in event 7/23. Terry Mayberry has agreed to assist in electrical work necessary to provide electric power for the event.
- 5) The electric fly-in event success depends on club member participation for mowing and general clean-up to prepare the field for the event. Gene will send out email for volunteers to assist on the day of the event. Gene will report on the success of the event at the August club meeting.
- 6) The Giant Scale fly-in is set for August 20<sup>th</sup> and Bob M will need assistance on the day of the event. Bob indicated this will be his last year as director of the event and David Boles has agreed to take over next year. To qualify as event director next year David has volunteered to assist at both the electric fly-in and giant scale events. Members present agreed to fund \$200 in door prizes purchased from Cookeville Hobbies and G & L Hobbies.
- 7) Field Improvements were voted on with expenditures not to exceed \$700.
  - a) Purchase garden tools to aid in general clean-up of the field.
  - b) Complete repairs to our existing fence and add additional fencing around our canopy. Fence materials posts, cable and hardware will need to be purchased

- to complete the project. Spacing between the fence and the canopy should provide clearance for the riding mower.
- c) Run the existing water line to the south end of the field;
  - d) Move the grandstand;
  - e) Run electrical power to the canopy and down the new fence line closer to the flight stations.
- 8) Thanks to Clay Vetter for building additional flight stations. A much appreciated addition to our field.
