

# Minutes of the Most Recent UCRCS Club Meeting August, 2011

## TREASURY REPORT:

Neil Ranft reviewed the Club's expenses, income and resulting bank balances.

## CLUB OPERATIONS:

## NEW BUSINESS:

1. Minutes of the Club meeting for July 2011 were accepted as revised.
2. Bob M. informed the members the cost for a booth at the Sparta Air Show September 17 will be a \$200 flat fee and a \$10 electrical hook-up fee. Members present voted to proceed with the fund raiser. Bob will have sign-up sheet at the next club meeting for volunteers to man the booth during the day of the event.
3. The electric fly-in event was a success with 16 pilots at the fly-in with a good time had by all. The next club meeting I will review income generated by the event.
4. The Giant Scale event is set for August 20th and Bob M will need assistance to get the field in top condition and help on the day of the event. Half time events will be a special treat with a giant scale heli demo, Chris K will fly his 12 ft Telemaster and Ricky Tan will show-off his flying skills. Re-affirmed to purchase door prizes from Cookeville Hobbies and G & L Hobbies not to exceed \$200; \_ Food will be barbeque, chips and cookies; \_ Steve M will MC the event and David Boles will assist as an event director; \_ Landing fee \$15, Lunch \$5: \_ Awards presented for best military aircraft, best civilian aircraft and best of show aircraft; \_ David B. will contact the Herald Citizen for advertisement and possible pictures taken by the H.C.
5. Field improvements were voted on with expenditures not to exceed \$700.
  - Purchase garden tools to aid in general clean-up of the field;
  - Complete repairs to our existing fence and add additional fencing around our canopy. Fence materials posts, cable and hardware will need to be purchased to complete the project. Spacing between the fence and the canopy should provide clearance for the riding mower;
  - Run the existing water line to the south end of the field quoted at \$150 in supplies and will begin after the Giant scale event;
  - Cost to extend power down the new fence line was agreed to be excessive members agreed to limit electrical power to the canopy;
  - Patch the tears in our runway. Manufacturer suggested using 6 minute epoxy. Ron suggested filling holes with sand or dirt before patching;

- Possible construction of a club house.
- 6. Portable toilet needs servicing prior to the Giant Scale event. Members agreed to pursue cost to replace the existing toilet with a larger unit. Neil R. agreed to contact Fay Portables.
- 7. David B. proposed and members present agreed to hold a Saturday event in the fall to support local charity such as Toys for Tots. Suggestions included a fly-in and open to the public with tickets sold to buddy box fly with club members. David B. will coordinate with other members to plan the event.
