- 4) Work Schedule at the field will be scheduled as weather conditions improve.
- 5) Club discussed a fund raising event at the Sparta Air Show this summer. Bob M suggested selling snow cones and ice cream as our previous event selling drinks was not a successful fund raiser. Bob will provide further details at the next meeting.
- 6) Opportunities for improving our flying field were discussed for the coming year. Suggestions included:
 - a) Addition of three safety tables.
 - b) Relocating our canopy to provide better access to mower
 - c) Moving our fence closer to the runway to allow set-up of canopies on either side of the fence for specators restraining non-members from the flight line and allowing space to setup canopies for pilots. Committee consisting of David

Boles, Tony Celli, Neil Ranft and Clay Vetter will discuss options at the next meeting.

- d) Setting a permanent electrical pole near the mower shed. Terry Mayberry will talk to the electric company to determine if there are any issues to setting a permanent electric service and cost of installation. Terry will report on his progress at the next meeting.

- 7) A suggestion is still on the table to schedule a work day for the field to clean up leftover construction and to empty the trash cans. No date was set, as the weather is uncertain this time of year. We will definitely need to do more work in the spring.

- 8) Show and tell:
Ron B. discussed 3rd generation upgrade of his Jet. Ron discussed the issue of determining the center of gravity of a bottom wing design by setting the plan upside down when using a center of gravity finder.
